

## **Change in Charcoal:**

### **Valerie Irwin Drawing Demolition at Cranfield's Flour Mill**

With the striking charcoal drawings of artist Valerie Irwin, this unique exhibition charts the recent changes at Ipswich docks, through the demolition of Cranfield's Flour Mill.

In 2005 Valerie Irwin took her sketchbook to Ipswich Marina and began to draw. Charting the work that took place, and the workmen that she encountered, the charcoal sketches span many months and depict the significant changes that happened on the waterfront.

With a mixture of detailed measured drawings, studies and action sketches of process and sequences, the pieces in the exhibition provide an interpretation of the changing landscape through the eyes of an artist.

Change in Charcoal can be enjoyed free in the surroundings of Gallery 3, in Ipswich Town Hall Galleries.
